You hear the *ir* sound at the end of the word *sir*. Say the *ir* sound three times: *ir*, *ir*, *ir* (point to the *ir* each time) (point to or) These letters, o and r, work together to make the sound or. You hear the or sound in the middle of the word worm. Say the or sound three times: or, or, or (point to the *or* each time) (point to *ur*) These letters, *u* and *r*, work together to make the sound *ur*. You hear the ur sound at the end of the word fur. Say the ur sound three times: ur, ur, ur (point to the *ur* each time) (point to ear) These letters, e, a, and r, work together to make the sound ear. You hear the *ear* sound at the beginning of the word *earn*. Say the *ear* sound three times: *ear*, *ear*, ear (point to the ear each time)
