Read the words in **bold** out loud to your learner.

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(point to *oy*) These letters, *o* and *y*, work together to make the sound *oy*.

You hear the *oy* sound at the end of the word *joy*. Say the *oy* sound three times: *oy*, *oy*, *oy* (point to the *oy* each time)

(point to oi) These letters, o and i, work together to make the sound oi.

You hear the *oi* sound at the beginning of the word *oil*. Say the *oi* sound three times: *oi*, *oi*, *oi* (point to the *oi* each time)
