### $\star$

(point to *ow*) These letters, *o* and *w*, work together to make the sound *ow*.

You hear the ow sound at the end of the word cow. Say the ow sound three times: ow, ow, ow

(point to the ow each time)

(point to ou) These letters, o and u, work together to make the sound ou.

You hear the *ou* sound at the end of the word *out*. Say the *ou* sound three times: *ou*, *ou*, *ou* (point to the *ou* each time)
