(point to au) These letters, a and u, work together to make the sound au.


You hear the au sound at the beginning of the word August. Say the au sound three times: au, au, au (point to the au each time)

(point to aw) These letters, a and w, work together to make the sound aw.

You hear the aw sound at the beginning of the word awesome. Say the aw sound three times: aw, aw, aw (point to the aw each time)
